

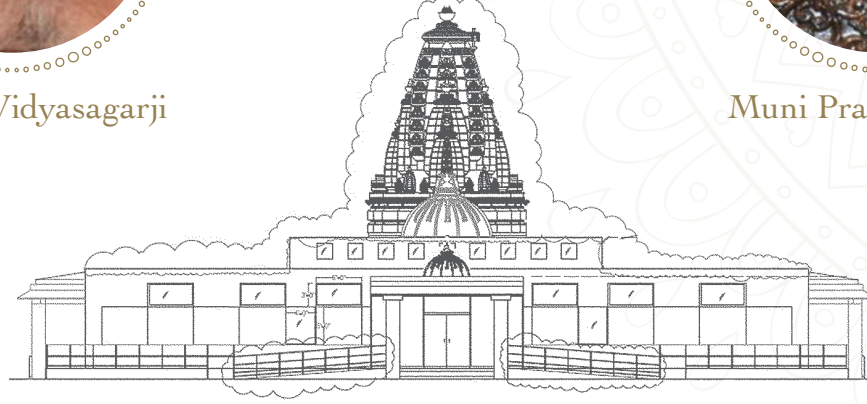

With immense pleasure, International Digambar Jain Organization (IDJO) cordially invite all our patrons, their friends, and families to a very auspicious event of Mandir Opening and Manstambh Pratistha at Digambar Jain Temple in Chantilly, Virginia, USA on September 9th and September 10th, 2023.

The Panch Kalyanak Pratistha rituals for all murtis were performed by Pratisthacharya Brahmachari Abhay Bhayaji under the guidance of Shri Pramansagarji maharaj in India and subsequent Vedi Pratistha was performed here from August 5th through August 7th, 2022.

Since then, we have finished construction of 33 feet tall Manstambh in front of the temple. According to Adi Purana and Tiloyapannati, a huge manastambha stands in front of the Samavasarana (divine preaching hall) of the tirthankaras, indicating those entering a Samavasarana to shed their pride. Our Manstambh will guide us to shed our pride and ego before entering the temple. Pandit Mahesh Kumar Jain will perform Manstambh Shuddhi, install Parshwanathji murtis on Manstambh (total four – one facing each direction) and perform poojan on September 10th, 2023.
